Sustainable Development Goal 14: Life Below Water Activities

1. Life Saving and Water Safety

Participants will put on their wetsuits and be guided by professional lifesavers, The Rescue Company. They will learn what to do in different emergency situations, and complete activities that focus on water safety and lifesaving.

2. Drøbak Aquarium

As well as a guided tour of the aquarium, participants will get the opportunity to further explore different species, then take a closer look at different forms of algae, starfish and microplastics found in the local area, using microscopes.

3. Kystlaget

Groups will go sightseeing on the Oslofjord, by speedboat, and get to explore the fjord and surrounding area of Drøbak. They will learn about the history, local nature and diverse species of bird and marine life.

They can also try steering the boat themselves. Hold on... its fast!



4. Natural Science Puzzle Challenge

Groups will be tasked with completing numerous natural science challenges. Once they have solved each problem, they will be given a letter that, once all collected, can be put together to reveal a secret key word. What will that word be? Well, that is part of the challenge.



5. Video Workshop

This is a creative and collaborative activity, where participants will make a short video based on SDG Goal 14: Life Below Water. It can be a thumping music video, a short sketch, or a mini documentary- the possibilities are endless. All videos will be screened later in the event.



6. Upcycled Land Art

Students will receive a lesson about the famous Norwegian artist, Edvard Munch, and one of his most famous paintings, The Scream. They will then be challenge to recreate this in an eco-art project that includes collecting trash or things from nature to use as their materials.
